A 68 year old Diabetic patient who was suffering from critical limb ischemia with a very large ulcer at the left ca and foot and had been advised amputation of the left lower limb, underwent autologous (One's own) bone marrow stem cell treatment at Vascular surgery department of Vijaya Hospital and 60 days later her ulcer healed and the new vessel formation improved the circulation to the affected area. The treatment was done by Dr S.I Subrammaniyan, Chief Vascular surgeon assisted by a team comprising of Dr Amalorpavanathan, Dr Rajkumar and Dr Shankar. The outcome of the patients status were presented at a Symposium on regenerative medicine held on the 17th of October 2006 and well accepted by the scientific community.
